BONNYVILLE, AB (February 10, 2021) – Imperial donated \$35,000 to Lakeland Catholic School Division (LCSD) to help support students with the many challenges that have resulted from COVID-19.

This donation will enable purchasing of materials, equipment, supplies and educational resources. The funding will also help cover the cost of educational training.

LCSD is working hard to support students through the changes that have resulted due to COVID-19. This grant will be used to complement the service delivery of the division’s existing psychologist and multi-disciplinary team including Speech Language Pathologists, an Occupational Therapist, an English as a Second Language (ESL) Support Teacher and an Indigenous Outreach Worker. This program ensures that LCSD’s students will be provided with the counselling and support services they require in order to be successful.

“The current environment has shone a special spotlight on mental wellness and the importance of support networks,” said Jack Fraser, Imperial’s Cold Lake Operations’ asset manager. “We commend Lakeland Catholic School Division’s efforts to bring awareness and services to its students and this investment reflects our commitment to support healthy minds in the communities where we operate.”
