Catholic Trusteeship



Have you ever considered running to be a trustee for a Catholic school division?

If you have, there is lots of information in this brochure to guide you through the process.

Eligibility to Vote in an Election

A person is eligible to vote in a school trustee election if they are:

- At least 18 years of age
- A Canadian citizen
- A resident of Alberta and their place of residence is located within the school board boundaries on election day.

A person can be nominated as a Catholic school board trustee in any election if they are:

- Eligible to vote
- Catholic
- A resident of the local jurisdiction and the Ward for at least 6 consecutive months immediately preceding the election; and
- Not otherwise ineligible.

Faith-based Eligibility

When a separate school division is established, an individual residing in the boundaries of the established areas is considered a separate school elector if they declare they are the same faith as those who established the separate school division (Catholic).

Who are Trustees and What do they do?

- Trustees are advocates for children assessing educational policies in terms of what is best for the development of the whole child.
- Trustees are responsible for ensuring that all children in the community receive a high quality education.
- Trustees are politicians, members of a government unit charged with the responsibility to govern the affairs of the school jurisdiction.
- Catholic school trustees also play an integral role as advocates for Catholic education by ensuring students receive an education permeated by our Catholic faith.
- As a governor of the Alberta Catholic school division, our Board of Trustees is accountable to the Bishop of the Diocese of St. Paul and the Minister of Education.
